NOTICE OF CO-OPTION

Notice is hereby given that a vacancy has occurred in the office of Parish Councillor.

As the required period for requesting an election has passed without an election being called, the Parish Council will fill the vacancy by **co-option**.

The Council invites applications from eligible members of the public who wish to serve the community of Hollym.

Who Can Apply?

To be eligible, you must:

- Be at least 18 years of age;
- Be a British citizen, qualifying Commonwealth citizen, or eligible EU citizen; and
- Meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - Registered as a local government elector for the parish;
 - Have lived in the parish for the past 12 months;
 - Have worked in the parish for the past 12 months;

You must not be disqualified under any relevant legislation.

Role of a Parish Councillor

Parish Councillors serve voluntarily and are responsible for:

- Representing the interests of residents;
- Attending Parish Council meetings and relevant training;
- Contributing to decision-making on local services, planning consultations and parish finances;
- Upholding high standards of conduct and public service.

How to Apply

Applications should be sent to the Parish Clerk by:

10th March 2026 at 12pm

Co-option will be considered at the next meeting of the Parish Council.
