| | <p><u>Christmas Lights</u> Discussion took place regarding replacing the Christmas Lights 2 x 50 Metres of Lights are required and it is thought Coloured Lights. The PC want to sort out the issue earlier in the year than before. Cllr. J Purse indicated to the Chair that he had some thoughts on the Christmas Lights and as both he and Cllr. Becky Lindgren was unable to make the meeting it was Agreed to again move this item forward onto the next agenda.</p> <p><u>Speeding Issues</u> Cllr. B Jull asked for this item to be added to the agenda. Following discussion with the Speed Monitoring Traffic Police (Motorcycle), it had been indicated to Cllr. Jull that if Hollym PC had a Lay Bye where a vehicle could park then the Van may monitor speed through the village more frequently. The Clerk confirmed that she had written to Highways at East Riding but was waiting for a response. In addition, the Clerk is to write to Safer Roads Humber to see if this would actually be the case.</p> <p><u>Drainage</u> Discussion took place regarding the Drainage issue on North Leys Road, Cllrs. Have visited the site but cannot identify a problem with the drainage on North Leys Road at the moment. The drains are running clear due to the recent heavy rainfall. It was Agreed to monitor the situation. In addition, Manor Lane was discussed, it was felt that part of this Lane does have a drainage problem which has been brought up with ERYC in the past during a Street scene walkabout and also last year photographs of the problem were sent to ERYC.
