	<p>Councillor Lyn Healing provided an update re Holderness Health and the move of the Phlebotomy Service to the GP Surgery. Existing Nurse, No Reduction in hours. Rationale behind the move is that the Nurse can see the full patient record and there will be no need for Blood Cards. Blood Nurse is able to make appointments for those patients with Chronic Diseases which require regular check-ups. The Children's Blood service is to remain at the Surgery.</p> <p>MI Unit - You do not have to be referred by the GP. Ring the GP Surgery and select line '4' and this takes you to a dedicated MI Assessor. If they cannot deal you will be referred on to Bransholme or Beverley. Transport from HU19 area is funded.</p> <p>LH is to explore the possibility of a dedicated phone line for the Blood Service.</p> <p>Also, the possibility of a 'Time Frame' being provided when you select the option for the 'Call Back' service.</p> <p>Chair asked why they are not 'Cutting Back' the overgrown verges on the main roads? LH advised that they have been reducing this for some time now. This is an area for Terry Weaver and as he has been in the area it is perhaps something he is looking at. LH asked everyone to remember that it is best to contact her with queries about issues prior to a meeting – this way she may be able to resolve or at least have some answers to anything raised at a meeting.</p>
