Comments have been made on Facebook - these are not relevant to the Parish Council suggestion has been that Councillors are on board with a planning application – the Chair made it clear that the Council is a 'Consultee' only in the planning process, the Planning Authority make the final decision and nothing is decided in this meeting other than the 'Consultee Comment'. The Council has the 'best interests' of the village at its heart.</p> <p>MOP 1 – Support of the Plough Inn and the other facilities in the Village – the Village Hall.</p> <p>MOP 2 – <u>Footpath</u> – Northside Road – still not repaired – he reported under the ERYC website, has a reference. <u>Bus Shelters</u> need cleaning – Chair confirmed Council has appointed a contractor to undertake the work.</p>	

	<p>Needles found in Bus Shelter – Chair confirmed please do not handle – report to ERYC and they will dispose of.</p> <p>MOP 3 – Asked for PC to support Plough Inn Planning Application</p> <p>MOP 4 – Race Night - Village Hall greatly enjoyed - an amazing Community Asset</p> <p>MOP 5 – Plough Inn – gets the community together and talking, fits into area.</p> <p>MOP 6 – Noted that most areas look for funding from regeneration grants etc. whereas the Plough Inn has funded all of this themselves.</p> <p>MOP 7 – Owners of Plough Inn have brought heart back into the village alongside the Church and Village Hall.</p> <p>MOP 8 – Plough Inn offering a public service, they check up on vulnerable in the village if they do not see them for a few days.</p> <p>MOP 9 – Rugby Club pleased with the success of the Plough Inn, players and spectators now stay back after rugby. Parking has previously been a problem, but the Rugby Club and the Plough Inn are working together to resolve this problem for the village.</p> <p>MOP 10 – Plough Inn has brought jobs and added value to houses because the village has a decent pub.</p> <p>MOP 11 – Can understand concerns – but if you purchase a house near to a pub there will always be the potential for it to get busy.</p> <p>MOP 12 – Raised concerns with Grass Cutting around the area.</p> <p>MOP 13 – Concerned with traffic – is there a potential for ERYC to instal mirrors where there is poor visibility – Chair confirmed this has been raised with ERYC previously and they do not support the installation of mirrors on highways.</p>
